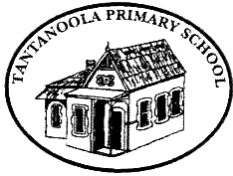

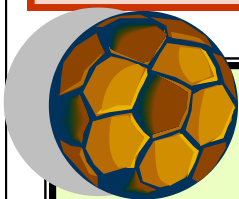
Training and Development
